## School Sports Code of Behaviour

This code of behaviour applies to players, coaches, parents and spectators of Henley Beach Primary School.

### PLAYERS

- Learn the rules of the game and play by them.
- Never argue with an umpire / official. If you disagree, talk to your coach during a break.
- Verbal abuse of umpires or other players or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not permitted.
- Work hard for your team as well as yourself.
- Be a good sport.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated.
- Co-operate with your coach, team mates, opponents and umpires.

### COACHES

- Ensure that all equipment and facilities are safe and appropriate to the age and ability of the players.
- Encourage and be positive with players, never shout at or ridicule them.
- Encourage players to develop their skills and to play by the rules.
- Ensure all players are given equal opportunity.
- Ensure all players respect their opponents, umpires / officials and opposing coaches.
- Be responsible for the behaviour of players under your control.
- Remove from the field of play any of your players whose behaviour is not appropriate.
- Assist the umpire / official to maintain control of the game.
- Take opportunities to learn more about the sport.
- Refer any unresolved issues to the Sports Committee or the Principal.

### PARENTS AND SPECTATORS

- Encourage participation by your child, but do not force an unwilling child.
- Understand that children participate in sport for their own enjoyment.
- Encourage honest effort, skilled performance and team loyalty, rather than the overall outcome of the game.
- Encourage players to play according to the rules and the umpires' decisions.
- Respect the umpire's decision. If you disagree, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than question the umpire's judgment or honesty in public.
- Applaud good performance and focus on the efforts by both teams.
- Never shout at or ridicule a child for making a mistake.
- Recognise the value and respect the decisions of coaches and umpires / officials.
- Advise the coach whenever a player cannot play in a scheduled game.
- Discuss any issues you may have with the coach and if not satisfactorily resolved, they may be referred to the delegate, Sports Committee or Principal.
- Do not tolerate the use of violence, verbal abuse or foul language in any form, be it from spectators, coaches, umpires or players.
